Stroke is the third leading cause of death in the United States and the primary cause of disability. If any of the following symptoms are present, call 911 immediately:

- Numbness, weakness or paralysis of the face or in an arm or leg, occurring in one or both sides of the body
- Sudden blurred or decreased vision in one or both eyes
- Difficulty speaking or understanding
- Dizziness, loss of balance or an unexplained fall
- Headache (usually severe and of abrupt onset) or unexplained change in headache pattern
